Sebastopol State Historic Site - 704 Zorn Street (1 mile from east of TLU campus off Court Street) - Tours are conducted Friday, Saturday and Sunday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Sebastopol House State Historic Site, located in Seguin, Guadalupe County, is an 1856 Greek Revival-style house sitting on 2.2 acres of its original 4-acre site. Sebastopol House is listed as a Registered Texas Historic Landmark and is in the National Register of Historic Places as a result of its unusual limestone construction and its architectural style.

Seguin Heritage Museum - 114 N. River in downtown Seguin. (One block north of the Guadalupe County Courthouse.) - The museum is open Monday-Friday 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thousands of years of history come alive in the objects that are on the display. Since being formed in 1997, the museum's permanent collection has grown to tens of thousands of objects from prehistoric artifacts to ceramics, jewelry, textiles, utility items, and photographs.

Seguin Outdoor Learning Center - 865 Hwy 90 E. - A full calendar of summer camps are planned for youth of all ages. Visit their web site at www.solic.org or call 379-7652 for more information.

Downtown Historic Walking Tour - Maps are available at the Seguin Area Chamber of Commerce, 427 N. Austin Street. Open Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m.-5 p.m. and Saturday 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Central Park, the traditional heart of the city, is home to the June Seguin statue and many historical markers. In the evening be sure to catch a glimpse of the light show at the beautiful fountain with multi-colored lights. The Seguin Conservation complex is one block south of the fountain down River Street. Walk on over and see an early pioneer log cabin, and the oldest Protestant church in Texas.

Use new call report to measure marketing efforts, analyze trends

The Call Report – What is it? Have you noticed a new addition to the Seguin Chamber's *BusinessLine* newsletter? You'll find it this month on page 5.

What is the report? The Call Report is a record of all incoming telephone calls, walk-in visitors, and e-mail requests received during a particular month.

Why do we report only incoming calls? Incoming calls and requests are calls generated by people who are actively seeking information from a credible source.

Why should you be interested in the report? The report provides useful information that you may share with others in your company about what types of information customers are looking for, how many requests are being made for relocation information, how often your business is being referred and how many visitors came to the chamber seeking tourist or business information.

How are calls being recorded? The chamber staff records each phone call or walk-in visit to the office, any e-mail requests for information and any tourist requests received on our 1-800 line.

Are requests for non-members recorded? Yes. Non-member companies that are referred (under our policy) are recorded in the call report. If you're being referred and you're not a chamber member, get that checkbook ready! There's a good chance we'll be asking you to join and receive all our member benefits!

How can I get a copy of the report? If you do not receive the Chamber's newsletter, contact us and we will e-mail a copy to you.
