

# HEAVENLY WHITE

**M** Maui, considered by many to be the most popular of the Hawaiian Islands, has a reputation for beautiful beaches and luxurious hotels. One of the most unique hotels in Maui is the Fairmont Kea Lani. Kea Lani in Hawaiian means "heavenly white". Fairmont's reputation for service and leisure activities abounds at the Kea Lani. In addition to the 22,000-square-foot water complex with 140 foot water slide, guests at this Maui resort enjoy an adults-only pool with spa tub and a children's wading pool. A fitness center provides cardio and strength-training equipment, free weights, and complimentary classes such as yoga and water aerobics. The Fairmont Kea Lani is also adjacent to three world-class championship courses and is home to the award winning SPA Kea Lani. Guests also get to enjoy a complimentary outrigger canoe excursion, where participants learn the basics of paddling, the history of the canoe and its importance to Hawaiian heritage, and examples of native chants used when navigating the ocean. Other cultural activities include hula dancing classes and whale watching. For families, the Fairmont offers a year-round kids club called the Keiki Lani Children's Program which provides half- and full-day activities for children ages 5-12. The resort also has several dining options including the renowned Nick's Fishmarket and KO.
