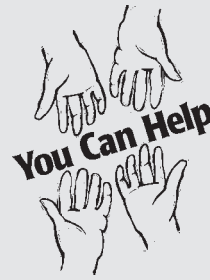
- Gladys Waggoner is making and donating her Christmas decorations.

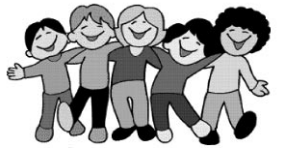
