Day 1 - Home/Vancouver Enjoy included roundtrip air on regularly scheduled flight. Upon arrival in Vancouver you will check in to your hotel and begin to enjoy with your personal escort this fabulous gateway to the Canadian Rockies. Day 2 - Vancouver This morning's city tour of Vancouver includes the harbor and beaches, Chinatown, and Stanley Park. Balance of the day is at leisure with multiple opportunities for additional adventure to be described by your escort. (B)

Day 3 - Vancouver-Rocky Mountaineer-Kamloops Arrive at Vancouver's Pacific Central Station and board your rocky Mountaineer train for a two-day, all-daylight, classic rail journey from the Pacific Coast to the Canadian Rockies. Travel through the fertile fields of the Fraser Valley surrounded by snow-capped Coast Mountains towards Fraser Canyon.
