Port Highlights:

ACAPULCO, MEXICO: The famous cliff divers of La Quebrada are just one of many attractions. You'll also enjoy shopping and people watching at the *Zocalo* (town square), or visiting one of the many spectacular beaches.

Connecting the Atlantic and Pacific - a dream of almost 400 years in the making

As the mammoth gates close and the water pours into the lock, the 92,000-ton ship on which you stand rises effortlessly. The Panama Canal was first considered in the early 16th century by King Charles V of Spain. 26,000 lives were lost during its construction. Five American presidents — Ulysses S. Grant, William McKinley, Theodore Roosevelt, William Howard Taft and Woodrow Wilson — played a role in the building of the Canal. It took the American government 10 years and \$383 million to finally complete. The Panama Canal is the “eighth wonder of the world”. The engineering feats employed — like cutting through nearly nine miles of solid granite at the Continental Divide and the use of gravity along to pull water from the locks from Gatun Lake — will leave you filled with admiration for the dreamers that make “connecting the seas” a reality.
