- ◆ **Muir Woods National Monument** Situated northwest of San Francisco on the slopes of Mount Tamalpais and reached via the Golden Gate Bridge this outstanding natural wonder is named for noted conservationist John Muir. It is one of the most beautiful and accessible of the famous redwood groves which 140 million years ago blanketed much of the Northern Hemisphere. Among trees featured are tallest trees on earth -- the Sequoias.
- ◆ **Golden Gate Bridge** This outstanding structure connects San Francisco with Marin County and the Redwood Highway. With

a length of 8,981 feet and main span length of 4,200 feet, it is one of the longest single-span suspension bridges ever built. Its two massive towers are the world’s highest bridge towers. A crew of painters constantly maintains the bridge’s distinctive coat of international orange. You will travel over the bridge.

- ◆ **Fisherman’s Wharf** This working wharf of San Francisco attracts millions of visitors annually and is filled with interesting and unusual shops and restaurants. **You’ll enjoy an included meal at one of our very favorite wharf restaurants.**
- ◆ **Cable Car Ride** A visit to San Francisco is not complete without a ride on a cable car, which is included. You will enjoy the most scenic - and steepest - route.

- ◆ **Jelly Bean Factory** You will enjoy a tour of this “gourmet” candy establishment, made famous by President Reagan’s fondness for this confection; and even learn about “belly flops”.
