

Passport Requirements/Deadlines

By January 1, 2008, all U.S. Citizens are required to have passports for travel within the Western Hemisphere, per the recommendations of the 9/11 Commission and the 2004 Intelligence Reform Bill. Going forward, a Passport will be required for U.S. Citizens who travel by air and sea to and from the Caribbean, Bermuda, Central and South America, Canada and Mexico. Subsequently, Passports or other accepted travel documents will also be required for U.S. land border crossings to and from Canada or Mexico.

The government has issued the following timeline for U.S. Citizens:

- **December 31, 2006** — Passport required for all air or sea travel within the Western Hemisphere.
- **December 31, 2007** — Passport required for all U.S. land border crossings.

Non-U.S. Citizens require a valid passport and visa (when necessary) in addition to an Alien Registration Card (A.R.C. or “Green” Card) if an individual is a Resident Alien living in the U.S.
