Alaskan Adventure

Tour Itinerary: This leisurely-paced journey into Alaska's heartland combines an extensive seven-day land tour, including three nights in Denali National Park and a seven-day cruise. Sightseeing also included in Fairbanks, Anchorage, Seward, Glacier Bay, Haines/Skagway, Juneau, Ketchikan and Vancouver.

Day 1, Tue., June 25: Chicago - Fairbanks, AK. Fly from Chicago's O'Hare Airport to Fairbanks, Alaska. Transfer to your downtown hotel. (Optional group transportation to O'Hare may be available from the Madison area.)

Day 2, Wed., June 26: Fairbanks - Denali. Enjoy your morning at leisure before taking a step back in time on board the sternwheeler Riverboat Discovery. Your three-hour cruise will introduce you to the rivers of Alaska featuring a floatplane takeoff, a stop at the home of four-time Iditarod champion Susan Butcher, and immersion into Athabascan culture at the Chena Indian Village. After a hearty lunch on the Chena River, head by motorcoach to Denali National Park. You are sure to enjoy your three-night stay at McKinley Chalet, a magnificent national treasure. (L)

Day 3, Thu., June 27: Denali. Wake up early this morning for a Tundra Wilderness tour (6-8 hours) deep into the park to look for wildlife. Grab your camera and binoculars to keep a lookout for caribou, Dall sheep, moose, grizzly bear or wolves. Visit the best lookouts for Mt. Denali, and weather permitting, become part of the Mt. Denali 30% club! The afternoon offers time to relax, take a hike with a National Park guide, or sign up for optional activities like flightseeing, river

Day 4, Fri., June 28: Denali. With so much to see and do in Denali, the day is free for you to explore. So many options: river rafting, fly over a glacier, stop at the Denali Park visitor center or just enjoy the beautiful property at the McKinley Chalet.

Day 5, Sat., June 29: Denali - Anchorage. This morning, board the luxurious domed rail cars of the McKinley Explorer bound for Anchorage, arriving late afternoon so you can explore the city sights at your leisure.



Day 6, Sun., June 30: Anchorage - Seward. Enjoy a memorable motorcoach ride viewing spectacular scenery along the Turnagain Arm and on to Seward, with time to explore on your own before you transfer to your floating hotel, Holland America's *ms Noordam*. (D)

Day 11, Fri., July 5: Ketchikan - 11:00a-7:00p. Explore the uniquely Alaskan port of Ketchikan, famous for its rich native culture, salmon fishing, and scenic Misty Fjords. (B,L,D)

Day 12, Sat., July 6: Scenic Cruising Inside Passage. Relax and enjoy a full day of scenic Inside Passage cruising and immerse yourself in Holland America Line elegance. Take the polar bear plunge, spend time in the spa, take a computer class or enjoy a cooking demonstration. There are so many things to do! (B,L,D)

Day 13, Sun., July 7: Vancouver and Return Trip Home. After disembarking, transfer to the airport for your flight back to Chicago.

TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport book (not card) that is valid for at least six months beyond the tour's conclusion with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements. It is recommended that any person charged with, or convicted of, a crime (including DUI) obtain the necessary approval before attempting to enter Canada. Non-U.S. citizens are responsible for confirming their own entry requirements.



Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted, although sometimes a cash discount may be offered. A deposit of **\$600 per person** is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by March 27, 2019.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows: 75-57 days prior to departure: Deposit; 56-29 days prior: 50% of total price; 28-16 days prior: 75% of total price; 15 days or less prior: 100% of total price. Given that the resale of cancelled space will likely result in a lost opportunity to sell other space, these fees are due regardless of resale. Cruise contracts are non-transferable. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from Burkhalter Tours, and we recommend purchase at the time of booking. Ask your agent for info.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Holland America tour departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 30 Burkhalter participants, a Burkhalter Tours host may travel with the group to provide additional customer service while traveling. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on September 10, 2018 and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour is based on a group air contract requiring a minimum of 10 travelers. Airline seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations. Deviations from the group air schedule may result in a different airfare. Routing and schedules are subject to change.

Accommodations/Coach Transportation: Tour hotels are considered the best available and include private ensuite facilities, typically with two beds. Touring coaches are deluxe vehicles with panoramic windows and seats that partially recline. Single travelers are allocated one seat only.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to board a motorcoach in a timely manner, climb stairs and walk moderate distances. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them - tour personnel cannot and will not provide such assistance.

Passenger Consent Agreement: Department of Transportation regulations require that we inform you that your purchase is subject to supplemental price increases beyond our control that may be imposed after the date of purchase. Such increases may come about due to increased fees, fuel surcharges, government tax increases, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination of these events. Post-purchase price increases may be applied to your invoice due to these unforeseen cost increases from suppliers. While a post-purchase price increase is very rare and not anticipated, Burkhalter Tours will inform you of any increases as soon as possible. By signing the tour application and making your deposit, you are acknowledging that you have been made aware and accept the fact that such increases may occur, and that you agree to pay Burkhalter Tours and our contracted suppliers accordingly.
