Snow Train

(Tentative Schedule)

Tuesday, February 23

5:30 a.m. Lv Visalia by motorcoach
6:30 a.m. Lv Fresno by motorcoach
11:33 a.m. Lv Sacramento. ALL ABOARD the Snow Train and off we go climbing up over the Sierras and down into Reno, NV.

On board the train, not only will there be beautiful scenery and hopefully some SNOW, but there will be onboard entertainment with strolling minstrels, historical narration, a piano lounge car and a café/bar in the Great Dome Car. This year's theme is Banjo Music. You may bring your own snacks and drinks. Cups and ice will be available on board. You will also have a coupon booklet worth looking through especially for offers at different hotels in Reno.

4:25 p.m. Upon arrival, walk 1 ½ blocks to our hotel or wait for the shuttle. Bags will be delivered to your rooms.

Wednesday, February 24

All day free to do whatever you would like. Check your coupon booklet.

Thursday, February 25

8:00 a.m. Bags will be picked up from INSIDE your rooms and transferred to the train depot.

Walk to train station or take hotel shuttle.

10:30 a.m. Lv Reno and go back over the magnificent Sierra Nevada Range. A deli lunch (included) will be available on the train. Once again ice and glasses will be available.

3:40 p.m. Arrive in Sacramento and transfer to our bus. We will make a dinner stop en route.

9:00 p.m. Arrive Fresno

10:00 p.m. Arrive Visalia

Important Group Information:

LUGGAGE: Pack carefully, and bring only what you are able to carry with you. There is no baggage car on this special single level train. Luggage space is above your seat only, and limited to normal size bags. We recommend luggage with wheels and to be under 2 ft wide by 3 ft long. Take your luggage off the train with you at Reno. Luggage handling at the Reno depot is not provided on this trip, unless prior arrangements have been made. Ask your Train Attendant for assistance if needed.

ABOARD THE TRAIN: You may bring aboard your own snacks and beverages, if you wish. A Café/Bar, located downstairs in the Great Dome Car, offers sandwiches, snacks, coffee, soft drinks, beer, wine and cocktails at popular prices. However, serving capacity is limited, so you may wish to bring a lunch. A Snow Train Snack Pack will be served at your seat on Tuesday around 3:00 p.m. If you bring an ice chest aboard, this must be taken with you to your hotel in Reno, as there is no secured storage aboard the train. For our return trip, a box lunch is included and served at your seat. The entrée is a turkey sandwich and pasta salad. Unfortunately, we are unable to make substitutions to our menu. However, should this meal not agree with you for any reason, you may bring your own food aboard, or you may purchase sandwiches, etc., in the Café/Bar. A full length Great Dome and a Piano Lounge Car are included on our train. You are invited to enjoy these cars if you wish. We ask that you limit your stay in each car to one hour per day so that others may have the opportunity to enjoy them.

SAFETY: Be sure to bring warm clothing, and comfortable walking shoes for use both aboard the train and on the often icy and slippery streets of Reno. Shoes must be worn aboard the train at all times.

TIPS: Each coach has an Amtrak Train Attendant. They are here to serve you and to insure the safety of every passenger. They work hard for your enjoyment and will attempt to honor your requests. With train travel it is customary to extend a gratuity to your Coach Attendant at the end of your trip when appropriate. You may wish to tip Bar Attendants and Entertainers, at your discretion to show appreciation for their efforts.
