The southern stingrays found at the sandbar called Stingray City in Grand Caymans North Sound are so habituated to human contact that they will happily allow themselves to be hand fed and even petted by visitors. Following a short transfer to the Cayman Islands Yacht Club, it is to this special place that you'll be sailing on board a catamaran. On arrival, you can take to the water to make personal contact with the friendly marine dwellers and feed them with scraps of food. The tour then draws to a close with an equally scenic sail back to the Yacht Club and onward transfer your ship. Please note: guests are recommended to bring swimwear, a towel, high-factor sunscreen, a sunhat and sunglasses. The catamaran provides only minimal shade. Guests must be at least 8 years of age to take part and, if younger than 16 years of age, must be accompanied by a paying adult throughout. The water may be deeper than 6 ft./182 cm and guests may have to swim to Stingray City. Guests will be required to wear buoyancy vests while in the water and remove footwear while on board the catamaran.

The thrill of riding a dolphin belly to belly is simply incomparable. Get to know the animals, enjoy a kiss or two. The final stop on your tour will be the famous sandbar called Stingray City (which you will reach by boat) for a chance to make personal contact with friendly southern stingrays in their natural habitat. **REEF & WRECK SNORKEL - GCA30**

Take yourself off the ship for half a day to discover two of the Cayman Islands best snorkelling sites, the first of which will be at the wreck of the USS Kittiwake. This former US Navy submarine rescue vessel was in service from 1946 right up to 1994, and then in 2009 was deliberately sunk at its present location off Seven Mile Beach to provide an artificial reef for local marine wildlife. While you snorkel around the 251 ft./76.5 m wreck, you'll be able to see its main decks, look down smokestacks and catch glimpses of the ship's hull and engine room. Next up is the so-called Cheeseburger Reef a name that comes from a nearby outlet of a global fast-food brand where a natural reef system can be enjoyed. At a depth of about 25 ft./7.6 m, you'll be able to snorkel to your hearts content. Finally and time permitting, the outing is rounded off with time to do some shopping in the centre of George Town before you return to the ship. Please note: guests must be at least 5 years of age to take part. Sightings of marine wildlife are common, but cannot be guaranteed.

Located at the western end of the island in the Artemisa Province, the UNESCO biosphere reserve is your destination for this full day off the ship. Your visit begins in Havana with a sightseeing of the exclusive Miramar residential neighbourhood to continue along the highway for a 80-km scenic drive to the Rosario Mountains. A stop at the lakeside Rancho Curujey restaurant will enable you to sip a welcome drink and admire the spectacular views of the surrounding mountains at the same time. Then, learn more about Las Terrazas Social Project and visit some places involved: Las Terrazas Community to know the way of life of its inhabitants, the Plaza de la Comunidad, the medical post to exchange with the doctor into the health system, the attributes of green medicine and other remedies. Do not miss the House of Memory for an exchange with the grandparents of the community and the studios of local artists, with whom you can interact and enjoy their works. Lunch then follows at a local restaurant, after which you'll take a walk down Callejón de la Moka to browse the artisans stalls at the Bazaar Cusco. As seeing the sights can be thirsty work, you'll head for a local restaurant where you will break for lunch. ## CUBAN ART AND CULTURAL DISCOVERY - CUB36

Start with a coach transfer to the Lawton district and Muraleando, a project founded by Cuban artists in 2001 that uses disused urban sites to showcase murales art. An example is a water tank turned art gallery that offers lessons for children and boasts its own Tank cocktail, made to a secret recipe. This enjoyable full-day tour in Havana and its surrounding areas enables you to get in touch with some of the local projects affecting Cuban life. A first stop will be in Lawton district, about 10 km from the city centre, to visit the Muraleando community project, founded in 2001 by a group of Cuban artists. Learn about the art of murales and discover how abandoned places were turned into art places; one of them is a tank, used to conserve water, and now become a large art gallery and classroom to teach children ceramic, plastic arts, dance, choir and guitar. A unique cocktail, the Tank, made with a secret recipe, comes from this place too. A short stop at Plaza de la Revolución will inform you of its historical importance, followed by lunch at a local restaurant. Leaving this district behind, reach Plaza la Revolución for a short stop and learn a little of Cuban history and the importance of the site for all Cuban people. A stop in a typical restaurant follows to enjoy a Cuban lunch. Moving on, enjoy views of Havana landmarks en route to Fusterlandia. Created by the internationally acclaimed artist, José Fuster, the community project features sculptures and mosaics. Walk around, take photos and perhaps find a memento. To round off the visit, you can sip a cocktail to a backdrop of fabulous vistas and savour a drive-by look at the Malecón esplanade, Hermanos Ameijeiras Hospital and Havanas historical quarter. The second leg of the excursion including a sightseeing coach drive to discover some of Havana main monuments until you reach the community project Fusterlandia, another of the projects dedicated to plastic arts especially mosaics, created by Fuster, an internationally recognized artist. Take your time to stroll around, to take pictures or buy a piece of Cuban art as a memory of this trip. A cocktail while enjoying wonderful views of the sea and a sightseeing drive including sights such as Malecón Avenue, the Hermanos Ameijeiras Hospital and old Old Havana concludes your day off the ship.
