HISTORIC & MODERN QUEBEC - Your tour begins with a narrated drive by Place Royale, a handsomely restored square in the heart of Lower Town boasting 17th and 18th-century stone architecture. The site of Samuel de Champlain's first settlement, the square is home to Notre Dame des Victoires, one of the oldest stone church still standing in North America Built in 1893 by the Canadian Pacific Railway, the palatial hotel Château Frontenac hosted Franklin Roosevelt, Winston Churchill and MacKenzie King when they met to discuss strategy during World War II Cap-Diamant ("Cape Diamond"), the official name of the promontory on which the Upper Town of Québec City is located. Upon arriving at Cap-Diamant, you'll embark on a narrated drive back to the pier. En route, you'll pass through Parc des Champs de Bataille, the site where the French surrendered to the British in 1759.

SAGUENAY HERITAGE ROUTE - Perched on the Saguenay and the Chicoutimi rivers, the name Chicoutimi means "the end of the deep water" in the native Innu language. Continue on to the Pulp Mill of Chicoutimi for your next photo stop. Listed on the Canadian Register as a National Historic Site Continuing on, you'll pass through the charming town of Arvida. As you travel along its winding, tree-lined streets, you may think it's a Hollywood set but Arvida was one of Canada's first pre-planned model towns. Built in 1927 for the workers of the Alcoa aluminum company, the town's unique and creative planning approach included 140 different models of single-family homes and a community of parks, schools and places of worship. Known as "the City Built in 135 Days," Arvida's historic district is listed as a National Historic Site Drive by the world's first aluminum bridge. The Arvida Bridge was built in 1950, the arched bridge spans 501 feet over the Saguenay gorge and is a monumental sight to behold.

LIGHTHOUSES OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND & SCENIC DRIVE -

Located in the southern part of the Gulf of St. Lawrence and separated from the mainland by the Northumberland Strait, Prince Edward Island is dotted with lighthouses: 50 in all! On this easy half-day tour, three different lighthouses point the way to a fascinating exploration filled with history, culture and fantastic photo opportunities Your first stop will on your itinerary is the dramatic Prim Point Lighthouse set against a wild, windswept landscape. Built in 1845, it is the first and oldest lighthouse on Prince Edward Island and one of only two round brick lighthouses in Canada. Standing just over 60 feet tall from foundation to weathervane, it consists of five levels all of which are connected by a series of wooden steps. Tarry at the lighthouse, photographing it from your ground level vantage point or step inside to climb to the breathtaking panorama at the top The next stop is the Wood Islands lighthouse. This charming structure was completed in 1876. It consists of a 52 foot square pyramidal wood tower with lantern and gallery, rising from one end of a 1-1/2 story wood keeper's house. The building is painted white with red trim and the lantern and keeper's house roof are red Completing your Prince Edward Island lighthouse experience is in Victoria Park from where you can view and take pictures of Brighton Beach Range Front Lighthouse. Built in 1890, the light shines directly at the entrance to Charlottetown Harbour with spectacular views in all directions During your return drive to your ship in Charlottetown, you'll be able to soak up even more of the beautiful countryside. Prince Edward Island, of Anne of Green Gables fame, boasts stunning scenery rightfully earning it the title of the "garden province" of Canada.

SYDNEY HIGHLIGHTS AND COASTAL DRIVE - Named by "Travel & Leisure" magazine as "The #1 Best Island to Visit in the Continental United States and Canada," Cape Breton Island boasts a rugged shoreline, rolling hills, and miles of unspoiled beauty and is the only place in North America where Gaelic is still spoken. As the island's largest town, Sydney has a rich and colorful history as a home to the Mi'kmaq people when French settlers arrived in 1604, and later as a British colony, a major Canadian seaport, and a port of entry for the 50,000 Scottish immigrants who arrived during the late 17th and early 18th centuries You will travel by many of Sydney's treasured buildings dating back to the early 1700's, including beautifully restored colonial homes that line the quiet tree lined streets of Wentworth Park and Whitney Avenue. You'll continue on through the centuries-old

industrial section of coal mining plants and steel mills. Your first stop is the Whitney Pier Historical Museum. Built around a steel plant and housed in a former Jewish synagogue, the museum is dedicated to preserving the legacy and culture of the 55 different ethnic groups that settled here and made Sydney their home. Enjoy complimentary tea and oatcakes as you view the photographs, newspaper clippings, and artifacts that reflect the area's diverse, rich culture Next you'll visit Fort Petrie Historical Site, home of Fort Petrie, one of seven fortifications that were used to protect Sydney Harbor during World Wars I and II. Walk up to the viewing platform for panoramic views of Sydney Harbor and sea birds such as puffins, gannets, razorbills and bald eagles.

PEGGY'S COVE & TITANIC RESTING PLACE - Peggy's Cove Fishing Village dates back to 1811, charming Peggy's Cove Fishing Village takes its name from St. Margaret's Bay. This rural fishing village, set against a backdrop of colorful fishing boats and the Atlantic Ocean, displays its maritime heritage around every corner and pays homage with its granite-carved DeGarthe Monument, which pays tribute to the local fishermen The Titanic sank approximately 750 miles from Halifax and has had a significant influence on the city's history. Fairview Lawn Cemetery is where the bodies of 121 victims of the Titanic, which were recovered from the icy waters of the Atlantic, were laid to rest. A kilted tour guide shares stories of the victims, including the true identities of the unknown child and J. Dawson, who fans of the film believe was the inspiration for Leonardo DiCaprio's character. Most of the victims are memorialized with gray granite markers, and the graves are arranged in the shape of a ship's hull Known as the City of Trees, lovely Halifax boasts a modern harbor and significant international port. The historic Halifax Town Clock overlooks the downtown core, and the fortress of Citadel Hill, a National Historic Site, is a star attraction. It is an approximately 60-minute drive to Peggy's Cove from Halifax, and you'll enjoy magnificent views as you travel along the lighthouse route while learning how glaciers and the force of the ocean waves have shaped the granite shores Perched high on a jagged outcrop of the eastern shore of St. Margaret's Bay, Peggy's Cove Lighthouse, built in 1915, is famed for its white-and-red design.

LULU LOBSTER BOAT RIDE - Step aboard the Downeast Maine lobster boat Lulu, a U.S. Coast Guard certified vessel outfitted with modern safety, navigation and communication equipment. As you sail the picturesque waters, you'll be regaled with tales of local history and folklore as you witness the chores of a lobsterman, such as hauling in the lobster traps and how they're baited. Conservation and sustainability of the fishery is discussed as well as the regulations protecting Maine's iconic resource. You will cruise Bar Harbor's Frenchman Bay and gaze out over the sparkling blue waters to observe sea birds, bald eagles and other marine wildlife in their natural environment. View Cadillac Mountain, the highest point on the eastern seaboard. At the bay's entrance you'll pass Egg Rock, home to the 40-foot tall Egg Rock Lighthouse. The views of Acadia National Park from the deck are incredible and the four islands that are seen dotting the bay are the Porcupines, an archipelago that consists of: Bald, Long, Sheep and Burnt Porcupine, which is privately owned, while the others are part of Acadia National Park.

Explore the quaint area of Lexington with a stop at the infamous Lexington Green. On April 19, 1775, less than 100 Minutemen faced 700 British soldiers. Kitson statue erected in 1900 that memorializes the Lexington Minutemen Concord played a leading role in American history. Admire the serene grounds surrounding the Old North Bridge. Lovingly restored, the bridge is famous for the 'shot heard 'round the world,' the site of the first American victory in the Revolutionary War Travel through Harvard Square past the hallowed halls of one of America's oldest and most prestigious universities..... Boston Driving Tour of landmarks and cultural sights are seen as this motorcoach tour winds its way through the historic streets and neighborhoods of Boston Faneuil Hall, hailed as the Cradle of Liberty, is a Georgian style building adjacent to the two story, 27,000 square foot Quincy Market, considered the social center of Boston.
