Daily Itinerary

Day: 1 - Montreal, Quebec

Inviting winter cityscapes await on a sojourn through the dazzling French-Canadian cities of Montreal and Quebec City. Arriving in Montreal, discover a blend of all things old and new. “Sugar Shack” Experience



Sugar shacks are small cabins in the woods where maple sap is collected and boiled into syrup. They are a place to celebrate the arrival of spring and the maple sap season. After eating, visitors can often enjoy folk music, go for a sleigh ride, or hike in the woods.

A breakfast at a Quebec sugar shack, or *cabanes à sucre*, is a festive all-you-can-eat meal featuring many dishes covered in maple syrup:

- **Soups:** Pea soup, warm yellow pea soup with ham hock
- **Savory dishes:** Maple-baked ham, sausages, baked beans, omelets, scrambled eggs, meat pie, pork pate, deep-fried pork jowls, and more
- **Side dishes:** Hash browns, pickled beets, homemade fruit ketchup
- **Desserts:** Crêpes, maple sugar pie, maple taffy on snow
