Great Irish Famine of the 1840s. Then, travel to the pilgrimage village of Knock. Drive along the beautiful coastline, visiting Kylemore Abbey and a marble workshop. The two night stay in the port city of Galway features an included excursion to the Aran Islands, famous for their linguistic and cultural heritage, and a genuine Irish farm experience. Also on the agenda: the breathtaking Cliffs of Moher, King John's castle in Limerick, and Foynes Flying Boat museum, where you can explore the only Boeing B314 "Clipper" full-size replica in the world. Enjoy a spectacular 100-mile panoramic drive around the Ring of Kerry, and then a horse-drawn jaunting cart ride in Killarney. Blarney, the House of Waterford Crystal, and St. Kevin's Centre of Irish Christianity at Glendalough are the final highlights before you return to Dublin for your last overnight on the Emerald Isle! Visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary in Fatima, where pilgrims from all over the world visit; Jeronimos Monastery in

Lisbon, built to thank the Virgin Mary for Portugal's success in its voyages around the world; the 13th-century cathedral and the Church of Santo Tomé in Toledo, which has one of El Greco's most famous paintings; and more. Members of this special departure will enjoy an included outstanding "PRESIDENTIAL BONUS" - an excursion to the Rock of Gibraltar, adding a true travel achievement to your travel accomplishments. Ferry crossings over the Strait of Gibraltar

On this faith-based tour, you will travel to some of Christianity's most important sites in Israel and spend time in Jordan -with overnights in Tel Aviv, the Sea of Galilee, Jerusalem, Amman, Petra, and the Dead Sea. In Jerusalem, you will visit the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed the night before his arrest; the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper; the House of Caiaphas, where Jesus was kept the night after his arrest; and more. You will walk Jesus' last

path along the Via Dolorosa and visit the most celebrated Christian church, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, erected on the site of the crucifixion. There will be time spent in the Sea of Galilee area, where much of Jesus' ministry occurred and where he walked on water. You will cruise on the Sea of Galilee and visit Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered his Sermon on the Mount; and visit the village of Cana, where Jesus changed water into wine, and Nazareth, the cradle of Christianity. But, that's not all...in the picturesque village of Ein Karem, you will visit the Church of St. John the Baptist, gathering spot of early Christians. Together, we will visit the ancient, fortified city of Megiddo, one of the world's most important biblical sites, and Masada, where a cable car to the top to see the well-preserved fortress will be experienced. Four-wheeling through sand dunes in Jordan will be a thrill; and visiting Petra, one of the New 7 Wonders of the World®, where you will walk down the Siq, a narrow gorge with spectacular colors flanked on either side by high cliffs. Here, you will also see the iconic and famed Treasury and sip tea in a Bedouin tent. Floating in the buoyant Dead Sea will also be experienced.
