Traveling the Back Roads of Texas Matagorda County - It's A Shore Thing by Casper

Matagorda County is a great place to spend a weekend, or if you're lucky, as we were, spend 4 or 5 days exploring all the county has to offer.



The first stop on your adventure should be Bay City and

the Matagorda County Convention & Visitors Bureau. Director of Tourism Rebecca Newman is a wonderful guide to shops, restaurants, and attractions. Bay City [pop. 18,000], located on the Colorado River about 80 miles southwest of Houston and 30 minutes from the Gulf, is the perfect start for exploring a region which combines abundant nature and Texas history dating back nearly 500 years. Bay City was established in 1894 and replaced the town of Matagorda as county seat the same year.



Bay City's town square, surrounding the 1965 courthouse, has lots to offer visitors. We started our day at Main Street Coffee and Wine Bar, which serves gourmet coffees and pastries as well as an excellent lunch selection of soups, sandwiches and desserts. Walking around the square, we enjoyed visiting the many shops, including Bay City Antique Mall, the Basket Shop & Boutique, Heart & Home, Bay City Floral, Homestead, and Mustard Seed Christian Store. Town Square Restaurant, across from the courthouse, is a great place for lunch while you shop.



Also located on the square is the Matagorda County Museum and Children's Museum. This award-winning museum has interesting displays covering Matagorda County history, the Karankawa Indians, and the excavation of LaSalle's ship, La Belle. The Children's Museum, known as "Our Town", is located downstairs and represents a small Texas town c. 1890-1910.



The museum is fully furnished and allows children of all ages to experience play in areas including a one-room, schoolhouse, general store, bank, jail, post office, ladies dress shop, barber shop, and prairie home.

After our busy day, we headed over to the K-2 Steakhouse for a delicious dinner. Bay City has a number of recommended restaurants and cafes, including El Zarape Cafe, La Casona Mexican Restaurant, Blue Ocean Seafood, Fat Grass Restaurant & Bar, China One Buffet, and Bay City Seafood and Steak. Many overnight options are available including Comfort Suites, Hampton Inn, LaQuinta, Studio 6, and a Fastline Motorcycle School at MSR Houston in Angleton on July 12.

The next day began with an early morning visit to the Matagorda County Birding Nature Center, just west of town. The 35-acre park is beautifully maintained and offers many different birding habitats and gardens to explore by foot or golf cart. This is an excellent place to relax and enjoy the natural surroundings. In the afternoon we travelled down to the small coastal town of Sargent, home of the last swing-bridge over the Intercoastal Waterway and a top fishing spot. Recommended restaurants in this area are The Blue Gecko Bar & Grill and Stingrays Bar & Grill.



The town of Matagorda [pop 600], is located on the Colorado River, and just a few minutes' drive from the Gulf. There are a number of interesting shops in town and we enjoyed visiting Lena's Landing Gift Shop and Matagorda Harbor House. We stopped by the harbor and marina, busy with fishermen, and watched the many towboats as they pushed lines of barges up the intercoastal waterway. The Waterfront Restaurant, overlooking the harbor, offered us a tasty lunch. Other recommended dining places include Spoonbill's Restaurant, Poco Playa, Snappers Bar and Grill, and Lighthouse BBQ.

A fun stop near Matagorda is the LCRA Matagorda Bay Nature Park. This 1600-acre park and preserve is operated by the Lower Colorado River Authority and includes two miles of beach on the Gulf, 2 miles of river frontage, and hundreds of acres of marshland and dunes, perfect for bird-watching and nature study. Kayak tours or rentals are available and the park includes RV and camping facilities.



An interesting historical stop is the Matagorda Cemetery, established in 1830, resting place of a number of early Texas pioneers and veterans of the Texas Revolution. After a seafood dinner at the River Bend Restaurant, we headed for our nights stay at the Lodge at Karankawa Village. The small lodge offers tastefully decorated rooms with extras like Keurig Coffee makers, bottles of spring water, homemade cookies, and comfortable covered lounge areas at the end of both floors.



The upscale Cattails Boutique is located across the lot and is a wonderful place to shop or enjoy gourmet coffee or a glass of wine before dinner.

The town of Palacios [pop. 5200], was established in 1902 and is located about 30 miles southwest of Bay City on land formerly owned by cattle baron A. H. "Shanghai" Pierce. Palacios is a quiet, slow paced city that is known as center for coastal shrimp fishing. Stop by the Chamber of Commerce office as you enter town for information on attractions and dining places. The City By The Sea Museum has interesting displays covering the towns' 100 year history, the excavation of LaSalle's ship La Belle, Hurricane Carla of 1961, the Karankawa Indians, and the agricultural and fishing history of the area. Palacios has very nice parks with sandy beach areas and shallow water and playgrounds for kids along Harbor Drive. Recommended restaurants here include The Lumberyard, Palacios Mexican Restaurant, Bayside Seafood, Tran's Vietnamese Restaurant, and Marisalas Cafe. A highlight of this stop was our night at the historic Luther Hotel. where you can enjoy the beautiful sunset and ocean breeze from the quiet front porch.



As we headed home the next day, we made a stop in the small town of Blessing at the historic Hotel Blessing Coffee Shop, home of famous homemade breakfasts and lunch buffets. The hotel still accepts guest and we look forward to a return visit.

Annual events in Matagorda County include the Matagorda County Fair & Livestock Show and the Matagorda Seafood Festival in March, LaSalle Landing Reenactment in July, Bay City Lion's Club Rice Festival and the Matagorda Heritage Day in September, and the Lighted Christmas Boat Parade in November, and many fishing tournaments during the year.

Our trip to Matagorda County was filled with new and exciting experiences and we look forward to our next visit.




