Florida Caverns State Park

Experience Florida's cave tours and marvel at the unusual formations found only at Florida's Caverns. The 45-minute guided cave tour explains the formation of stalactites, stalagmites, draperies, soda straws, columns, rimstone pools, and other fragile cave-drip formations. Appreciate the wildlife living in these caves - blind cave crayfish, cave salamanders, and three species of cave-roosting bats. The visitors center features an extensive display of maps, exhibits, historic artifacts and a video tour of all activities at the 1,300 acre Florida Caverns.



Marianna Historic Homes Tour

Marianna was named the City of Southern Charm in 2005 and is steeped in history. It is located in Jackson County, the third oldest county in Florida. The Old Spanish Trail travels through here. More than 56 historic sites are spread out through Marianna. The tour mixes walking and driving to view the historic sites. The guided walking tour begins at a gorgeous old home built in 1895. It serves as the visitors center and tells the story of five generations to many visitors. The home is placed on the National Registry of Historic Homes in 1996. The guided tour walks by several old antebellum homes to view.
